## 2021 TRMA Awards

Thank you for being a member of the TRMA and casting your vote for the 2021 Trop Rock Music Awards.

Winners were announced at the awards show in Key West on November 5th.

Definition of Trop Rock Music: Tropical Rock (or Trop Rock) is a genre of popular music that incorporates elements of Rock and Roll, Country, Caribbean, Reggae or other musical genres to create a laid-back or "escapist" state of mind. Trop Rock may create its tropical or "island vibe" either with tropical or island-like instrumentation and production, or with beach, tropical or escapist virical themes, or both.

#### 1. Male Vocalist

Awarded to the top vote getter for excellence in performing and recording by a trop rock male vocalist, including a male vocalist performing in a duo, trio or band, during the eligibility year.

#### 2. Female Vocalist

Awarded to the top vote getter for excellence in performing and recording by a trop rock female vocalist, including a female vocalist performing in a duo, trio or band, during the eligibility year.

## 3. Duo/Trio

Awarded to the top vote getter for excellence in performing or recording as a trop rock duo or trio during the eligibility year.

## 4. Band

Awarded to the top vote getter for excellence in performing or recording as a trop rock band of four or more members during the eligibility year.

## 5. Entertainer of the Year

Awarded to the top vote getting Trop Rock solo, duo, trio or band, for excellence in all aspects of entertaining, including live performance, recording, song writing, video and broadcast, during the eligibility year.

## 6. Album

Awarded to the top vote getting qualifying trop rock album, defined as an independent release of eight or more songs or 30 minutes of playing time, released during the eligible year, or in the 12 months preceding the eligibility year if the album was not on the final ballot in the preceding awards period. Awarded to Artist and Producer(s) (if the producer(s) is/are other than artist).

## 7a. Song

Awarded to the Songwriter (listed in parenthesis). Given to the top vote getting qualifying trop rock song released during the eligible year, or in the 12 months preceding the eligibility year if the song was not on the final ballot in the preceding awards period. The song need not be part of a qualifying album. This category is open to all artists, not only TRMA Academy members like other categories.

• "The Wave" - Donny Brewer (Donny Brewer & Eric Erdman)

## 7b. Single

Awarded to artist and producer (listed in parenthesis), if other than the artist. Given to top vote getting qualifying trop rock recording released during the eligible year, or in the 12 months preceding the eligibility year if the recording was not on the final ballot in the preceding awards period. The recording need not be part of a qualifying album. This category is open to all artists, not only TRMA Academy members like other categories.

• "Low Key" - Aaron Scherz feat. Mike Nash (Aaron Scherz)

## 8. Music Video of the Year

Awarded to the top vote getting official artist-sanctioned music video for a qualifying trop rock song, which video was released during the eligible year, or in the 12 months preceding the eligibility year if the video was not on the

final ballot in the preceding awards period. The song need not have been released in the eligibility year. Awarded to Artist(s) and Video producer/director (in parenthesis).

• "Single For Summer" - Erica Sunshine Lee (Erica Sunshine Lee & Joshua Mendez)

## 9. Best Album Art/Packaging

Awarded to the top vote getting trop rock album or EP cover art/design and packaging for an album or EP released during the eligibility year, or in the 12 months preceding the eligibility year for an album was not on the final ballot in the preceding awards year for Album of the Year or Best Art/Packaging. Awarded to artist and designer/artist (in parenthesis).

• Gulf Coast Happy Hour - Jonas Lorence Band (Jonas Lorence)

## 10. Horizon Awar

Awarded to the top vote-getting Trop Rock solo, duo, trio, or band who shows the most promise for contributing to the Trop Rock genre through performance, songwriting and recording. Previous winners are not eligible.

## 11. Musician

Awarded to the top vote getting trop rock musicians for outstanding musicianship, intended to recognize band members, or musicians for excellence in performing and/or recording in support of trop rock artists during the eligibility year.

## 12. Songwriter

Awarded to the top vote getter for excellence in trop rock songwriting.

#### 13. Radio Station

Awarded to a radio station for excellence in trop rock radio broadcasting during the eligibility year.

#### 14. Radio Program

There are two Radio Program categories on the ballot - "live" and "recorded". Please vote for one show in each category.

#### 15. Live Music Venue

Awarded to the top vote getting venue for outstanding presentation of live trop rock music during the eligibility year.

## 16. House Concert Venue

Small & Large Awarded to the top vote getter for outstanding house concert venue - small and large, based on annual attendance with the threshold to be determined annually at the discretion of the Awards committee. Awarded to the host/hostesses of non-profit concert-style home-based venues featuring Trop Rock artists.

#### 17. Event of the Year

Small & Large Awarded to the top vote getters for outstanding events, small and large, featuring multiple trop rock artists. Meeting of the Minds is excluded from this category because it is a National Convention. Small and large categories based on total registration, with the threshold to be determined annually at the discretion of the awards committee.
